

2 x 2 Stripes

Source – Learn to Knit Afghan Book by
Barbara Walker

Materials – Red Heart Worsted Acrylic Yarn - Color A
and Color B
size US 8/5.0mm needles

Gauge – 16 sts over 4in/10cm over stockinette stitch



Note: It is not necessary to cut the yarn each time there is a color change. Leave the unused color attached and when it is time to change color bring the new color from below and behind the old color and begin knitting across the row. The two colors will be carried up the right side of the swatch along the selvedge and only a few yarn tails will need to be woven in when the swatch is complete.

With color A cast on 34 sts.

Row 1 (RS): with color A - knit

Row 2: with color A – purl

Row 3: with color B – knit

Row 4: with color B - purl

Repeat rows 1-4 twelve times then rows 1 and 2 again (50 rows). With color A bind off. Block if needed and weave in yarn tails.
